BRECON MARKET STORE CATTLE REPORT Friday 27th July 2018

Store Cattle

The sale was certainly a challenge however the trade was much better than expected with steers still topping at £1340 and heifers up to £1315 but the weather certainly did have an effect on the trade together with the recent decline in fat prices. However, the stronger cattle especially heifers were easily sold and the quality cattle would still have been around 250-260p/kg with plenty of demand as those cattle seldom rely on grazing.

There was an entry of smaller dairy bred types and these were more difficult to sell but did attract sufficient interest and were all sold. The average trade was perhaps £60-£70 down on recent months and steers would have averaged 216p/kg while heifers were a slightly stronger trade at 217.5p/kg which taking all things into consideration was an excellent result. The best well meated lambs were a good trade topping at 200p/kg with a pen from A E Jones, Coedmore Hall. I cannot stress how important it is when farmers are drawing lambs that their lambs are full of meat. On the whole trade this week was better than expected and certainly better than the end of last week. The mediums sold to average 174pkg and topped at 178pkg from A G Smout Bailey Griffith. With the next festival coming up, buyers will start looking for Tup lambs and small lambs will be in demand but again they must be meat. Buyers will not bid for lean lambs!!!
