An identical entry of prime Hoggets to last week in terms of numbers with a better show in terms of overall quality. The average was back on the week but up on the previous day's trading. The trade was boosted by the improved quality forward with another large proportion of quality lambs within the desired weight spectrum and meat cover forward. The better bred heavy lambs produced the highest considerations of the day and the handy weight lambs producing best returns per kilo. We again reiterate that we need a larger weekly entry to meet buyer demand with the number forward today again not sufficient for all our valued customer base to fulfil orders. Follow our predictions through the week via social media and the website and we hope for another fast trade and a larger entry next week. The SQQ average of £1.95ppk and the overall average of £1.92ppk is affected by the strength of sterling against the euro and trade could rise dramatically if sterling weakens and supplies tighten further.
