General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

As a result of the GDPR legislation which came in to force in May 2018, and in order to fulfil our health and safety obligations to our employees, we have reluctantly taken the decision to introduce a security system in our offices at Ludlow, Worcester and Brecon livestock markets.

In the past, access to the office and reception area has not been restricted. However, the implementation of this system will mean that only employees and authorised personnel will be able to enter this area of the building, and access to this area from the main door in reception and the back office door to the cattle sale ring will be restricted accordingly.

This system will be activated on 1st April 2019 and while we appreciate that this may initially cause some inconvenience, we would ask for your understanding and cooperation.

The market staff have been instructed to ensure that the system is implemented and is not compromised or abused in any way.
