Privacy Policy

At Avery Cole Estate Agents, we're committed to respecting and protecting your privacy.

This Privacy Policy explains when and why we collect personal information about our website visitors, customers and people who contact or interact with us, how we use it, the conditions under which we may disclose it to others and how we keep it secure.

How do we collect personal information about you?

We obtain personal information about you that you provide to us through our website, emails, phone conversations, documents you provide to us or when you visit our office, for example when you:

- Enquire about specific properties for sale or for rent
- Ask us to value your property
- Register for our email information
- Interact with us on social media sites

We also obtain personal information relating to you using automated technical means when you visit our website.

What personal data we collect

The information we collect from you might include (but is not limited to) your name, address, email address, phone number, date of birth and financial details and any other information you choose to provide to us. By using our services or visiting our site, we may collect this personal information and depending on the service you are engaging with, we will collect other information relevant to and necessary for us to provide that service to you. For certain services, bank details or credit card information may be required.

We do not collect personal data considered as sensitive personal data such as health related information except when required for employees of Avery Cole.

In addition, we may receive certain categories of personal data and some device information (such as your name, email, browsing history on our sites and other details) from sources other than you, such as from third party sites, applications and services.

How we use your personal data

We may use your information for the following purposes: to provide you with services and fulfil your requests, to provide the functionality offered on our site, to pay for services, to respond to or follow up on enquiries, to tailor your experience on our site including displaying relevant properties, to provide information and services to our customers, to perform statistical analysis, to protect against fraudulent, unauthorised or illegal activity, to comply with our policies, procedures and legal

obligations and as otherwise consented to by you and as required or permitted by applicable law.

If you do not provide us with certain information, we may not be able to fulfil your request or provide certain services.

We do not perform automated decision taking or 'profiling' by solely automatic means; there is human intervention in our processing and decision making.

Legal bases for processing personal data

When you engage with AVERY COLE, there are a number of legal bases under which we may request, process and use your data, including:

- Asking for your consent to receive email marketing and to refer you to use our additional services ie referencing etc. Your consent is not assumed and you can withdraw or change your consent at any time.
- Where we have a legal duty, such as complying with anti-money laundering legislation
- To enable us to fulfil a contract
- Legitimate interest, for example where we discuss related services or provide you with the details of properties to help with your property search. When you register your property search with Avery Cole, you will be sent properties listed to ensure we can best service your request and find you the right property.

Where the provision of data is a statutory or contractual requirement, or necessary to enter into or fulfil a contract, we will make this clear in our terms and conditions and contracts. Should the requested data be refused, it may not be possible to proceed with the service required.

Aggregated information

We may aggregate personal information collected from you and other customers as well as device information and location information (with your consent, where required) to provide general statistics that

cannot be linked to you or any other specific user and with which we attempt to provide you with a better experience to improve our services.

Retention periods

We will retain your information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Policy and as otherwise needed to comply with applicable law and internal company policies. The length of time between transactions in the industry has been taken into account when determining how long data is retained for.

Cookies and tracking technologies

Technologies such as: cookies, beacons, tags and scripts are used by Avery Cole and our partners, affiliates, analytics or service providers. These technologies are used in analysing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We may receive reports based on the use of these technologies by these companies on an individual as well as aggregated basis.

Cookies are very small text files that are stored on your computer when you visit some websites. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. We use cookies to help identify your computer so we can tailor your user experience.

You can disable any cookies already stored on your computer, but these may stop our website from functioning properly. Please visit www.allaboutcookies.org if you would like more information, including how to see what cookies have been stored in your web browser and how to manage and delete them.

Calls made to phone numbers on our website and marketing materials may be recorded for training purposes. Log File Information: Log file information is automatically reported by your browser each time you access a web page on our Service. When you access the Service, our servers automatically record certain information that your web browser sends whenever you visit any website. These server logs may include information such as your web request, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, referring / exit pages and URLs, number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed, and other such information. We do not link this automatically-collected data to personally identifiable information.

Who we share your personal data with

We may share your data with third parties, to help manage our business and deliver services. These third parties may include but are not limited to:

- Service providers, who help manage our IT and back office systems.
- Credit and reference checking agencies including HomeLet, Rentshield, Rent4sure.
- Suppliers who need to carry out work on your property
- Our regulators, which may include the ICO, as well as other regulators and law enforcement agencies
- Solicitors and other professional services firms (including our auditors)

How we protect your personal data

AVERY COLE values your privacy and data security. We use third party services to help maintain the security and performance of our systems and sites. Email monitoring software and network traffic firewalls are also used. You can be assured that any personal data we gather about you through our sites, email, social media, telephone or other means will not be passed on to any third party or organisation except in the instances outlined above.

We will never change our bank details during the course of a transaction. Always query emails supposedly from us where the sender's email address does not match our domain averycole.com or where the format, style or content is not usual. We will always check when we receive an instruction to amend our record of a customer's details.
